NAZARETH HOUSE (c.1941) - Another of Father John Hawes' designs, the building was originally intended as an orphanage. It is of interest mainly for the controlled severity of its design.

LIGHTHOUSE KEEPERS COTTAGE - Built in 1876, the cottage now houses the headquarters of the Geraldton Historical Society.

STOCK FENCES - In the early years, cattle were off-loaded from ships and swam to shore. Fences were used to guide stock before being driven into town stockyards. Remains of the fences are still visible in the dunes and on the reef.

GERALDTON MUSEUM - Houses a number of permanent and changing displays, including exciting maritime displays from the 17th and 18th century Dutch ships wrecked off the coast.

BILL SEWELL COMPLEX - Houses the Tourist Bureau and Old Gaol Craft Centre. **Batavia Backpackers**

ART GALLERY - Designed as the finest outside the Perth metropolitan area. Open Monday to Friday.

THE RESIDENCY - Originally the home of the first Government Resident in Geraldton, the building is now the headquarters of the Cultural Trust, as well as housing a display of arts and crafts.

LIVE CRAYFISH FACTORY - Tours available.

FISHERMANS WHARF - Dozens of "crayboats" can be seen unloading their catch during the rock lobster season. (November to June).

ST FRANCIS XAVIER CATHEDRAL - Designed by architect-priest, Father John Hawes, the cathedral was not completed until 1938 (although commenced in 1916). It is of Byzantine style architecture.

MONSIGNOR HAWES HERITAGE TRAIL - A self-guiding driving tour through the scenic Murchison region. It includes 15 buildings designed by the architect priest, Father John Hawes.

SEPARATION POINT LOOKOUT - Views to Southgate Dunes, overlooking Greys Beach and Mahomets Flats.

GREGORY STREET - Named after surveyor A.C. Gregory, some of the oldest buildings in Geraldton can be found on the northern end of this street. These include the first shop built in the town, the original Geraldton Bakery and the Geraldton Hotel.
